A medical team headed by Dr. Sharma will carry out a check up for all students and staff and that Sai Doctors will continue to render regular check ups and follow ups.



Sai youth - Mr. Vishal Malde informed that youth wing has brought 80 Citrus fruit tree which they will be planting with the help of students.

"SERVE THE PLANET" GO GREEN EXHIBITION

Students expounded on the "Serve the Planet" exhibition which helps the entire school community in practicing Sathya Sai Baba's message on "Ceiling on Desires. School cares for the environment by practicing the five inherent human values of Truth, Peace, Love, Non-violence and Right Conduct. Students stressed that it is our obligation to protect the planet, serve mother earth by taking care of the environment for our own spiritual uplift since there is an interconnection between God, Nature and Man.



CITRUS FRUIT TREE PLANTING

Esteemed visitors along with students and teachers formed two groups. Group A planted 51 trees in the Orange Orchard, whilst group B planted 30 trees in the Lemon Orchard.



FARM TOUR

At the farm, the guests were taken through the main farm activities in the school including:-

- Propagation of seedlings and raising nursery beds
- Tilling of land
- Care and maintenance of crops at the farm including weeding.
- Thinning, Top dressing, Final harvesting



The visitors admired on how students maintain their allocated beds with pegs marked showing details of the student name, date when a particular crop was planted, expected maturity date and how the farm produce helps to supplement the kitchen requirements.

MEDICAL CHECK UP OF STUDENTS

Sai Doctors accompanied Dr. Sharma and their medical team carried out a free medical check up for students for any possible signs or symptoms of medical conditions by asking series of questions and through physical examination of chest, eyes, nose and throat, lungs, abdomen, skin and dental. Ten students were identified by opticians for vision correction and were later provided with spectacles. Six students had their periodontal scaling done and root planning by removing dental plaque and tartar. Sai Doctors will continue with regular check ups and after care.



VALUE BASED PRESENTATIONS BY STUDENTS

After everyone has settled in the auditorium by 1.30 p.m, students presented the following:-

- **National Anthem played on flutes, followed by School Anthem "Love All Serve All"**
